TALKING POINTS FOR YOU

- Ohio is seeing significant spread from things like parties, weddings, funerals, and other informal gatherings. Please be cautious any time you are in a setting with individuals who reside outside of your household.
- The entire state of Ohio now has a "high incidence" of COVID-19 spread – meaning the risk of encountering the virus in all 88 counties is very high. The virus is spreading significantly into counties that had not seen high rates of coronavirus in the past.
- The improvement of our economy is tied to the decrease in COVID-19 spread. If consumers don't want to leave home because community spread is high, then they're not out shopping at our local businesses. It's up to all of us to prevent coronavirus spread to keep the economy on the right track.

What You Can Do
